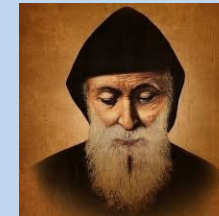

## Relics Of St Charbel, Whitehall

The relics of St Charbel will be visiting the Church of the Holy Child, The Thatch Road, Whitehall, Dublin 9, D09 E2R2 from Friday, October 25, until Monday, October 28. St Charbel was a Lebanese Maronite monk. He has the highest number of miracles ever recorded in Church history through the intercession of a monk.



## Praying With The Scriptures

In preparation for the Holy Year which will be celebrated by the whole church in 2025, Pope Francis asked that 2024 be observed as a "Year of Prayer". To help us appreciate this opportunity to grow in our relationship with God, Fr Anthony O'Leary CP will be offering three sessions at **Mount Argus** on "Praying with the Scriptures". These will be held in the St Charles Centre, beside Mount Argus Church, on three Tuesdays in October, beginning at 7.30pm. All are welcome. Fr Anthony was Associate Professor of Sacred Scripture at the former Milltown Institute and invited lecturer at St Patrick's College, Maynooth and Carlow.
