World Mission Sunday

What is World Mission Sunday?

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. It takes place in every single parish worldwide where the Church is present. In Ireland, Missio Ireland is tasked with organizing the Mission Sunday collection. Missio Ireland is the Popes official charity for overseas mission.

Why is it so important?

All offerings made on behalf of World Mission Sunday become part of the Holy Father's Universal Solidarity Fund. This Fund supports missionary activities in over 1,150 young diocese; mostly in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. As young diocese grow, so do their needs. On top of this, they are often found in remote areas devastated by conflict or natural; disasters. The Universal Solidarity Fund provides aid so that missionaries can continue to go to these places to share the love of God.
